1. What is the ONE most immediate need upon returning to your country?

***The creation of the technical unit in charge of school feeding: “There is a single point of leadership at a high government level responsible for program oversight and a clearly defined organizational structure that brings all sectors of government together to plan, implement and evaluate”***

Why?

***Without a clear organizational unit within the Ministry of Education and Culture that could have an oversight of the program it will be impossible to implement any of the policies or actions related to school feeding (at least in an orderly and integrated manner)***

***The Municipalities and Prefectures, through the financing of the program and technical oversight and parents and children for its actual implementation.***

***To lobby for the promulgation of the School Feeding Law and negotiate with the Ministries of Planning and Economy the allocation of financial resources to Prefectures and municipalities.***
