URGENT: Ind. 2.1 Partners participate in planning, implementation and feedback to promote mutual benefit

ACTION STEP: Development of a country strategy and programme in order to define its justification, strategies, objectives, results interventions, beneficiaries (use of) resources, coordination among institutions and modalities of M&E.

To pass from the current level of execution of school feeding, to an authentic School Feeding Program, strengthening the existent system of financial transfer to School Boards. I.e. to develop a logical framework with well defined objectives and watch over closely that the food (which are a means to an end) contribute efficiently to improve the educational and nutritional conditions of girls and boys that are the purpose of the programme.

DIFFICULT: Ind. 2.1. The participation of partners in a joint effort will be very difficult to achieve.
